


## Station 5.


Learn about the Asian longhorned beetle and why it is important to identify this exotic, tree-killing insect.

## Station 1.


What is a "Bluebird Trail"?  
Learn all about bluebird nesting boxes at Lockwood Farm.



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
## Station 2.
