



The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 recognizes the needs of the Department of Defense to sustain, restore, and modernize their military facilities. In accordance with this Act, the National Guard Bureau (NGB) is granting a portion of the ARRA funds it has received to the State of Connecticut Military Department (CTMD) for this purpose. The CTMD is charged by the NGB with contracting with state vendors to make the necessary improvements to the facilities identified in the Project List.
