



## **EEB TO HOLD PUBLIC INPUT SESSION FOR C&LM PLAN UPDATE**

Monday, May 16, 2016

The Connecticut Energy Efficiency Board (“EEB”) will hold a public input session for the 2017 Update to the 2016-2018 Conservation and Load Management Plan on Wednesday, June 8, 2016 from 1:00 – 4:00 pm at 10 Franklin Square in New Britain.

The EEB welcomes input as part of a collaborative process with utility companies, the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (“DEEP”), the CT Green Bank, interested stakeholders and the general public, for developing the 2017 Update to the 2016-2018 Conservation and Load Management Plan (“Update”). The Update will provide recommendations to the DEEP and the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority about the allocation of Connecticut Energy Efficiency Fund resources for energy efficiency programs and related activities. The EEB is interested in receiving public comments on what should be included in the Update, and on what key issues the EEB should take into consideration in developing the Update. Established through CGS 16-245m, the EEB is comprised of ten voting members representing business and consumer interests as well as state agencies, and five non-voting representatives of the state’s electric and gas utilities. It advises and assists the utilities in the development and implementation of Connecticut’s energy efficiency and load management plans.
