

KINDERGARTEN ENROLLMENT BY SCHOOL DISTRICTS SCHOOL YEAR 2014-2015

The following information is derived from the preliminary October 1, 2014 student census data submitted to the State Department of Education.¹

FULL DAY

A full-day kindergarten program provides 900 hours of actual schoolwork for a minimum of 180 days. Approximately 94% of Connecticut kindergarteners are enrolled in full-day programs.

One hundred and forty-three (143) school districts, thirteen (13) Charter Schools and fourteen (14) Magnet Schools provide full-day kindergarten to all children. For the basis of this report, any district with 95%-100% enrollment in full-day kindergarten was considered for this category.

EXTENDED DAY

An *extended-day* kindergarten program provides more than 450 hours but less than 900 hours of actual schoolwork for a minimum of 180 days. Approximately 2% of all kindergarteners are enrolled in extended day programs.

Three (3) school districts provide **extended-day** programs to **all children**. For the basis of this report, any district with 95-100% enrollment in extended-day kindergarten was considered for this category.

HALF DAY

A *half-day* kindergarten program provides 450 hours of actual schoolwork for a minimum of 180 days. Approximately 4% of all kindergarteners are enrolled in half-day programs.

Six (6) school districts provide **half-day** kindergarten to **all children**. For the basis of this report any district with 95%-100% enrollment in half-day kindergarten was considered for this category.
