NOTICE OF DECLARATORY RULING

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 4-176 (a) and Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies § 19a-643-24 (a), Greenwich Hospital and Yale-New Haven Hospital (“Petitioners”) filed a Petition for Declaratory Ruling with the Office of Health Care Access (“OHCA”) on August 11, 2009. The Petitioners requested that OHCA issue a declaratory ruling on the following issue:

Whether Connecticut General Statutes §§ 19a-634 and 19a-637 require or allow OHCA to exclude patients who live out of state, but are treated in a Connecticut health care facility, when evaluating the need for a particular health care service.

The above notice has been prepared in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes § 4-176. Pursuant to § 4-176, OHCA will receive and consider arguments and opinions pertaining to the issue presented above. All persons seeking status to participate in the declaratory ruling proceedings must petition OHCA for such status by October 15, 2009. All petitions for status must conform to Connecticut General Statutes § 4-176 (d) and the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies §§ 19a-643-24 and 19a-643-37 through 19a-643-39.

OHCA anticipates that it will issue a decision on the Petition for Declaratory Ruling on or before February 4, 2010.
