Part of a nationwide network of protection and advocacy systems, the Office operates under both State and Federal legislative mandates in pursuit of legal and administrative remedies on behalf of people with disabilities who experience disability-related discrimination.

On June 24, 2015, the OPA attorneys were recognized and received Law Enforcement Awards from the United States Attorney's Office, District of Connecticut, for their dedication in securing and safeguarding the civil rights of persons with disabilities.
