Agency Description:

This reduction is being submitted with Secretary Barnes' reduction option directive in his 9/5/14 memo to state agencies.
 This cut reflects a reduction in funding for the Public Housing Resident Network (PHRN), a state-wide non-profit organization that provides outreach and training to public housing residents. While the reduction will likely alter PHRN's scope of services, this reduced amount more closely reflects the \$75,000 PHRN was receiving from the Connecticut Housing Finance Authority (CHFA) for many years to conduct similar advocacy activities before CHFA selected a different organization to conduct these duties during a Request for Proposals process earlier this year. Through the coordination of existing resources, public housing residents will receive thorough education and training to ensure their participation in the redevelopment of their homes.

This reduction is being submitted with Secretary Barnes' reduction option directive in his 9/5/14 memo to state agencies. This 5% reduction will decrease DOH's payments to 16 participating municipalities under the Moderate Rental Payment in Lieu of Taxes program. Several municipalities will receive a few thousand dollars less annually from DOH. A reduction of \$45,404 to East Hartford is included in this cut due to the impending sale of King Court.

This reduction is being submitted with Secretary Barnes' reduction option directive in his 9/5/14 memo to state agencies.
 DOH is proposing an almost 10% reduction in funding for the Tax Abatement program. This cut will cause a reduction in payments to the 14 participating municipalities; several will receive a few thousand dollars less annually from DOH. Depending on their individual contracts, municipalities may opt to seek compensation for this loss from the participating affordable housing developments, which may lead to rent increases for the low- and moderate-income individuals and families residing there.
