RE: Budget Reduction Option

Dear Secretary Barnes

This letter is in response to your communication of September 5, 2014 requesting FY 2016 Budget Adjustments for the FY 2016 and FY 2017 Biennium. As you know, productivity improvements have helped the agency operate within significantly reduced appropriations but filled staffing in many areas is marginal. After review of the agency's programs and available resources, the Department of Revenue Services (DRS) submits the attached Budget Reduction Option equal to approximately .75% of our FY 2016 and FY 2017 budget requests. This option represents expenditure reductions totaling \$535,000 for FY 2016 and \$540,200 for FY 2017. This proposed reduction is only achievable by deferring the re-fill of vacant positions which we believe will be difficult but achievable.

Please be aware that DRS cannot absorb a reduction beyond what is being submitted without significant adverse impact on operations, revenue collection and filled positions. As you are aware the overwhelming majority (88%) of the DRS budget provides essential Personal Services. With agency staffing still significantly reduced over the past several years, there is little room for reductions in Personal Services. Similarly, the current budget for other expenses was very tight to begin with and the cuts required to produce more than a .75% reduction will seriously impact the Department's capacity to perform its core functions – including the levels of tax revenue generation and collection required to finance the FY 2016 & FY 2017/ state budgets.

While DRS is unable to absorb more than this requested reduction, we are prepared to propose expansion and enhancement options that will result in net additional revenue collection. We will be pleased to meet and discuss such options at your convenience.

As always, please let me know of any additional information that may be required or otherwise helpful as you assist Governor Malloy in continuing to stabilize our state finances.
