**Quarterly Activities/Project Description\***  
 The appliance replacement rebate program ended on July 15, 2010. Qualified appliances had to be purchased by July 15th and applications for rebates had to be postmarked not later than August 16, 2010. Some applicants were given until mid September to respond and correct their applications if they were incomplete or if inaccurate information was submitted. Publicly the program has smoothly come to an end without any public relation problems. Our utility partners are now reviewing the results of how much money was allocated and disbursed as part of the rebate program. We expect a final tally to be included in the reporting due for the Quarter ending 9/30/2010. It is anticipated that rebates provided may have slightly exceeded available funding under this American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) grant. In accordance with guidance from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), we anticipate using other ARRA grant resources (specifically the ARRA-State Energy Program (SEP) grant) to cover any funding gaps. We anticipate final close out of this grant to be completed before the end of the next quarter.
