STATE VICTIM ADVOCATE GARVIN AMBROSE APPLAUDS THE FINAL PASSAGE OF A BILL IMPROVING CAMPUS SEXUAL ASSAULT AND INTIMATE PARTNER VIOLENCE POLICIES

(Hartford, CT) --- State Victim Advocate Garvin G. Ambrose applauds members of the General Assembly for passing HB 5029, An Act Concerning Sexual Assault, Stalking, and Intimate Partner Violence on Campus.

“Members of the House and Senate passed this bill unanimously, clearly showing that Connecticut takes this issue seriously, and is committed to being a national leader in creating sexual assault and intimate partner violence policies for all college campuses to adopt,” said Ambrose.

“I applaud the General Assembly for making student safety a clear priority by addressing this issue before the end of the legislative session, when very few other bills have actually passed through both chambers. I urge the Governor to sign this legislation when it reaches his desk, and look forward to seeing these policies implemented and monitoring their results.”
