INSPIRATION FROM A SURVIVOR



Interval House and CRT's programs supporting victims of domestic violence provide a lifeline to a better future for courageous women in need of support.

Crystal Garrett, 32, turned to CRT's Supportive Housing program after a traumatizing string of domestic violence incidents with a boyfriend. When you talk to her, you can feel her willful strength she emanates as that of a confident mother, devoted family member and someone who feels close to God. Despite this disposition, she was no match for a man who towered over her and clenched his fists tighter the more he drank in their apartment.

Crystal was pregnant when things spiraled out of control one night, and despite being strangled and beaten as she tried to evade his pursuit, she managed to slip out the front door and run out onto the street without shoes or any of her belongings. Finding refuge at a gas station, she called the police and then her friend before she sat and waited to be saved as her heart pounded through her chest.

She connected with CRT and started case management to get her back on her feet. She had her beautiful baby girl. She received job training services and job leads from CRT that got her back on her career track to becoming a Certified Nursing Assistant. CRT helped her find an apartment and furnishings to make it a home.

She was starting to make it again — a better life was coming to fruition. And the boyfriend was sitting in a jail cell.

Crystal felt strong enough to speak at last year's Tee Off tournament, and her words embodied her determination to seek a better life. "I have to be strong so others can be strong. I have real goals in mind for my future, and this man has not ended my life."

She went on to say, "we all can make a difference because this battle with abuse goes on and there are others out there that haven't been able to escape like I did. If I can help inspire us to help the community save even one more person, that would mean a real victory in this struggle."
