Questions**

Question:

I'm excavating on
PRIVATE PROPERTY,
do I need to call CBYD?

Answer: YES!

You must call CBYD prior
to excavating ANYWHERE
in the State of
Connecticut, even on
private property.

FACT or FICTION:

Underground utilities
are **ALWAYS** at least
two feet deep.

FICTION!

Underground utilities
could be at ANY DEPTH,
so Exercise Caution!

Question:

Do all underground facilities have warning tape above them?

Answer: NO!

Older facilities, and
newer facilities installed
by trenchless
excavation, *may not
have warning tape.*

Question:

Do I need to call CBYD
if I am only GRADING?

Answer: YES!

Grading is considered
excavation, and you
MUST CALL CBYD
before grading!

Question:

Do I need to call CBYD
if I am hand digging?

Answer:

While calling CBYD for
hand digging is not
required, it is a
GOOD IDEA!!!

Question:

When does a CBYD
ticket expire?

Answer:

**Thirty (30) days from the
date the call is made
to CBYD
(NOT 30 days from the
start date!)**

Question:

My GC called in a ticket for the job, am I covered under that ticket?

Answer:

CT Regulations require that the person or company ***directly performing the excavation*** must call.

Question:

I'm digging over a gas line, can I dig the first foot with the machine before hand digging?

Answer:

NO!!!

You **MUST** hand dig to locate the gas line! Using mechanical equipment over the gas line is a **VIOLATION OF CONNECTICUT LAW!**
