

Connecticut's Implementation of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 - October 2010 Quarterly progress report

Jobs:

Recovery Act jobs created/retained during the quarter (July 1 – September 30) = **7,519**

Recovery Act job numbers for the reporting period (July 1 – September 30), by sector:

Funds:

Recovery Act funds that have come into CT including entitlement programs (FMAP, SNAP, Unemployment) = **\$3,630,088,878**

Recovery Act funding through grants = **\$1,813,596,264**

Grant expenditures = **\$781,383,886** (compared to \$596,145,462 on June 30, 2010)

Total dollars going out (combined totals between Recovery Act grant expenditures and Recovery Act entitlement benefits) = **\$2,597,876,500.19**

Transportation

Transportation jobs, raw numbers = 22,235 individuals employed on transportation projects funded by the Recovery Act since February 2009

- *Nearly 9,000 more individuals added for transportation projects between July and October.*
- Number of highway/bridge projects under contract = 133
- Number of transportation projects completed = 68
- *46 projects completed between July and October*
- Amount outlayed for transportation projects = \$169 million
- *\$50 million in new outlays between July and October*

Health and Environment

- Number of children receiving rotavirus vaccinations = 11,000
- Number of rotavirus doses administered = 23,059
- Drinking Water projects – status:
 - Number of drinking water projects = 12
 - Number of projects underway = 12
 - Number of projects completed = 4
- Clean Water projects – status:
 - Number of projects: 4 combined sewer overflow projects and 1 electrical generation project
 - Number of projects underway = 5

Education

- Number of grants Education has made = more than 1,100 grants awarded to school districts
- Education dollars awarded to towns/LEAs = more than \$446 million sent out to school districts

Public Safety

- Number of ICAC cases opened = more than 230 investigations conducted and arrested 19 individuals
- Number of ICAC training sessions = more than 60 presentations to 5,600 individuals; Computer Crimes Unit has trained more than 500 law enforcement officers
- DNA profiles processed = 26,000 convicted offender samples have been processed and entered into the CODIS databank
- Number of communities receiving JAG = more than 155

Research

- Number of grants received by UConn = more than 100 grants for greater than \$40 million

Energy

- Energy efficiency projects in state buildings = 12 projects for \$5 million
 - Number of projects underway = 2
 - Number of projects completed = 10
- Weatherization status =
 - Number of units fully weatherized = more 2,373
 - Number of units audited = more than 3,000

Housing

- Housing projects funded by Recovery Act tax exchange programs:
 - Number of projects funded = 14
 - Number of units being constructed = 845 affordable rental homes
 - Number of projects underway = 10
 - Recovery Act funding = \$92 million
