I. Call to Order

Chairman Cashman called the meeting to order at 9:13 A.M. Commissioners Gerratana and Bozzuto were present. Agency staff was also present.

VII. *Administrative Reports*

Mr. Lenge updated the Commission on the bi-weekly meetings with the forms subcommittee and the Information Technology Department addressing revisions that are currently being made to the eCRIS forms and other interface features. Future renovations to consolidate the physical layout of the agency were also discussed.

Ms. Rotman mentioned the Special Election that was held on March 24, 2009 and that David Baram, a participant in the Citizen Elections Program was successful in his bid for office.

Ms. Andrews congratulated Attorney Shannon Bergquist on the birth of her second child Tyler and notified the Commission that she will be on maternity leave for the next six months.
