15a. "Fedele for Governor" Supplemental Grant Determination 2010 Republican Gubernatorial Primary.

Ms. Rotman described the law applicable to Supplemental Grants and that the expenditure threshold has been reached by the Foley campaign.

It was moved by Commissioner Bozzuto and seconded by Commissioner Jenkins to approve the supplemental grant to "Fedele for Governor," Michael C. Fedele in the amount of \$973,500.00. So voted.

16. "Donovan 2010," Christopher G. Donovan

It was moved by Commissioner Jenkins and seconded by Commissioner Stankevicius to approve the grant application for "Donovan 2010," Christopher G. Donovan. So voted.

**IV. Adjournment**


