It was moved by Commissioner Jenkins and seconded by Commissioner Bozzuto that the Commission finds reason to believe that Respondent Anthony Ford violated Connecticut General Statutes §9-608 and §9-623 and that a Hearing Officer be designated for this matter. So voted. Chairman Cashman designated himself as Hearing Officer for File No. 2008-117NF.

VI. Legislation

Mr. Garfield notified the Commission that the Governor's second budget deficit mitigation plan would be voted on today by both chambers.

Mr. Garfield expressed his appreciation to the Appropriations Committee for their invitation to discuss the impact of the Governor's proposed plan on the Citizens' Election Program and their acceptance of his proposed alternative recommendation on returning funds from the Citizen's Election Program to aid the Governor's request for deficit reduction.

Mr. Garfield addressed previously proposed Legislative recommendations with the Commission and complimented Attorney James Talbert-Slagle for his work on the proposed draft bill concerning legal defense funds but has decided that he will not pursue this bill.

Ms. Rotman discussed changes with the Commission on the proposed legislation for the Citizen's Election Program.

It was moved by Commissioner Gerratana and seconded by Commissioner Bozzuto to approve the submission of an Act Concerning the Citizens' Election Program. So voted.

VII. *Administrative Reports*

Mr. Garfield informed the Commission that the January 12, 2009 eCRIS filings went well with two hundred and ninety six filers (296) using the electronic system.

The Citizens' Election Fund is receiving surplus funds from candidates that participated in the program.

Litigation preparation continues for the March 11, 2009 and March 12, 2009 hearings.

VIII. *Adjournment*

It was moved by Commissioner Bozzuto and seconded by Commissioner Gerratana at 11:34 A.M. to adjourn the meeting. So voted. Unless otherwise indicated, all votes of the Commission were unanimous.
