***I. Call to Order***

Chairman Cashman called the meeting to order at 4:04P.M. Commissioners Gerratana and Bozzuto were present via teleconference. Agency staff were also present.

***II. Consideration of Application for Public Grants from the Citizens' Election Fund***

Dianna Kulmacz, Director of Campaign Disclosure and Audit, summarized the following application and staff recommendation.
