JANUARY 3, 2008

I. Call to Order

Chairman Cashman called the meeting to order at 1:07 P.M. Commissioner Jenkins, Bozzuto and Gerratana were present. The Agency staff was also present.

II. Consideration of Application of “Friends of Kenny”, for a Public Grant from the Citizens’ Election Fund, in connection with the January 15, 2008 Special Election for the 32nd Senatorial District.

Dianna Kulmacz presented the audit report for the Citizens’ Election Programs “Friends of Kenny”, Candidate Kenneth J. Curran. Ms. Kulmacz and her unit have reviewed all the paperwork and documentation that was submitted. Following the audit, staff confirmed that the committee has met the qualifying threshold and all other requirements and qualifies for the grant approval.

It was moved by Commissioner Cashman and seconded by Commissioner Jenkins, Commissioner Gerratana and Commissioner Bozzuto to approve the grant application for “Friends of Kenny” based on the staff recommendation and presentation. So voted. The initial grant to this committee is \$63,750.
