MINUTES OF THE STATE ELECTIONS ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION
EMERGENCY MEETING
FEBRUARY 20, 2008

I. Call to Order

Chairman Cashman called the meeting to order at 9:21 A.M. Commissioner's Jenkins, Bozzuto and Gerratana were present. Agency Staff were also present.

II. Consideration of Applications of Robert D. Russo (“Russo for Senate”) and Thomas A. Mulligan (“Tom Mulligan for State Senate,”) for Grants from the Citizens’ Election Fund, in connection with the Special Election in the 22nd Senatorial District to be held March 11, 2008.

Dianna Kulmacz presented the audit reports for the Citizens’ Election Program grant applications for candidates Thomas A. Mulligan (“Tom Mulligan for State Senate”) and Robert D. Russo (“Russo for Senate”). Ms. Kulmacz and her audit unit have reviewed all the paperwork and documentation that was submitted with the grant applications. The audit staff concluded that the committees have met the qualifying threshold and all other requirements to qualify for grant approval.

It was moved by Commissioner Jenkins, and seconded by Commissioner Gerratana, to approve the grant application for “Tom Mulligan for State Senate” based on the staff recommendation and presentation. So voted. The initial grant to this committee, “Tom Mulligan for State Senate” is \$63,750. Also moved by Commissioner Jenkins, and seconded by Commissioner Gerratana, was approval of the grant application for “Russo for Senate.” The initial grant to this committee is \$63,582.00 based on the staff recommendation and presentation. So voted.

III. Adjournment

It was moved by Commissioner Cashman and seconded by Commissioner Bozzuto at 9:28 A.M. to adjourn the meeting. So voted.

Unless otherwise indicated, all votes of the Commission were unanimous.
