Ms. Kulmacz indicated there are presently sixteen (16) additional grant applications that have been submitted, possibly more.


Ms. Rotman gave a running count of participants for the Citizens' Election Program indicating one hundred sixty one (161) candidates are participating in the House, forty four (44) participants in the Senate and only six (6) non-participants in the House. We are very pleased to have broken the two hundred mark (200). The Citizens' Election Program trainings are continuing almost weekly and continue to be well attended. The current training schedule is listed on the State Elections Enforcement Commission website. Ms. Rotman stated that we are receiving positive feedback from participants.

*VI. Adjournment*


