1. Committees organized for the 2010 election cycle in a prior calendar year (i.e. 2007, 2008, etc.) are only required to file the April 10, July 10, October 10 and January 10 quarterly filings in the calendar year or years preceding the year of the election for which they are organized, beginning on the first quarterly filing that becomes due after the committee's date of organization. Candidate and Exploratory Committees for Statewide and General Assembly offices must file either the "Itemized Campaign Finance Disclosure Statement—Candidates for Statewide offices and General Assembly" (SEEC Form 30) or, if qualified, the "Short Form Campaign Finance Disclosure Statement" (SEEC Form 21). By contrast, Durational Political committees organized for the 2010 election cycle must file either the "Itemized Campaign Finance Disclosure Statement—PAC's and Party Committees" (SEEC Form 20) or, if qualified, the "Short Form Campaign Finance Disclosure Statement" (SEEC Form 21). The filing period begins on the first day following the end of the period covered. Statements may never be submitted within the period covered but only on or after the beginning date of the filing period. Statements filed after the applicable deadline of the filing period will be subject to a mandatory \$100 civil penalty. If the Short Form Campaign Finance Disclosure (SEEC Form 21) was previously used and the filing is the committee's first "Itemized

Campaign Finance Disclosure Statement” (SEEC Form 30 or SEEC Form 20, as the case may be), then the first day of the period covered goes back to the first day of the period covered in the first filing following the day of the committee’s organization.
