EPCRA Plan Review and Update
Request for Proposals RFP #DEEP-MMCA-SERC-03062014-2**

The State of Connecticut, Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) on behalf of the State Emergency Response Commission (SERC) is seeking a firm or contractor to review and assess all local emergency response plans prepared by Connecticut's Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPCs) and also to establish the activity level for Connecticut's LEPCs. The project will determine if these plans and committees comply with the established requirements of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act of 1986 (EPCRA). The plans were originally prepared in 1988-89 and EPCRA requires that such plans be reviewed at least once a year and updated as necessary. The plans are located at the regional offices of the Department of Emergency Services and Public Protection, Division of Emergency Management and Homeland Security (DEMHS).

Funding for this project will be provided by the U. S. Department of Transportation, Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration. The proposed budget for this project is \$30,570.
