NOTICE OF INTENT TO AMEND A REGULATION

In accordance with section 4-168(a) of the Connecticut General Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Insurance Commissioner, pursuant to the authority of section 38a-475 of the Connecticut General Statutes, proposes to adopt amended regulations concerning Conditions for Approval to Participate in the Connecticut Partnership for Long Term Care.

Statement of purpose: These amendments clarify the parameters for increases in premium and consequent effects on coverage. The amendments also describe limits on premium increases, and increases in benefit levels pursuant to the authority of Title 38a-475 of the Connecticut General Statutes.

All interested persons are invited to submit written data, views or arguments in connection with the proposed action within thirty days following publication of this notice on the Secretary of State's regulations webpage to the State of Connecticut, Insurance Department, Attention: Ralph Chin, P.O. Box 816, Hartford, CT 06142-0816.
