

Directions to Travelers Claim University 99 Lamberton Road, Windsor, CT

From Points North:

- Take Route 91 South to Exit 38 – Poquonock/Route 75.
- Stay left to go onto the Day Hill Road ramp.
- Stay straight to go onto Day Hill Road.



- At the first light, make a left onto Lamberton Road.
- Stay on Lamberton Road for approximately ½ mile.
- Claim University is the large white building on the right side of the road set up a bit from the road. Go past the building and use the second entrance.
- The main entrance is on the south side of the building under the canopy. Look for Claim University in red.

From Points South:

- Take Route 91 North to Exit 38 – Poquonock/Day Hill Road/Route 75.
- At the end of the ramp you will bear right onto Route 75/Poquonock Avenue.
- Stay on Route 75, go under the underpass and continue until you see the Day Hill Road/Windsor Corporate Area entrance on the right.
- Stay in the left lane once on Day Hill Road.
- At the first light, make a left onto Lamberton Road.
- Stay on Lamberton Road for approximately ½ mile.
- Claim University is the large white building on the right side of the road set up a bit from the road. Go past the building and use the second entrance.
- The main entrance is on the south side of the building under the canopy. Look for Claim University in red.
