Request for Proposal for Services

The State of Connecticut Department of Economic & Community Development (DECD) in collaboration with the Department of Labor and the CT Manufacturing Innovation Fund (MIF) Advisory Board is pleased to issue a Request for Proposal to create a Mobile Manufacturing Training Lab(s) Program for the State of Connecticut.

The Mobile Manufacturing Training Labs program, as defined under Substitute Senate Bill No. 448, Special Act No. 18-24: an act concerning a Request for Proposals for the operation of mobile manufacturing training lab(s) to operate one or more mobile manufacturing training labs that supports manufacturing careers by providing services that may include, but need not be limited to, continuing education for manufacturing employees and demonstration of advanced manufacturing to middle and high school students.

Minimum Qualifications

Have Experience in:

- Creating a manufacturing mobile lab program;
- Acquiring, operating and maintaining a mobile lab; and
- Providing advanced manufacturing curriculum and instruction.

Applicants Must Provide:

- A three-year plan
- A budget with sources and uses of funds including the request for MIF funding and other funds leveraged.
- A short description as to what the DECD funding will be used for.

All awards shall be made on a competitive basis.
