787 **individuals** received scholarship assistance (see categories below).

1. Additionally, 57 licensed child care programs under active status with the Accreditation Facilitation Project (AFP) received group-based scholarships to fund 101 professional development activities ranging from contract classes to training and coaching.

2. \$867,578 was committed to college-credit coursework and related fees.

3. \$1,001 was committed to foreign degree services (translation and equivalency).

4. \$67,872 was committed to continuing education (non-credit) coursework and \$134,667 was committed to professional development (includes AFP PD funding).

5. \$9,375 was committed to Pathways Exams.

6. \$6,775 was committed to Connecticut Director Credential (CDC) fees.

7. \$4,841 was committed to CDA credential fees.

8. \$100,890 was committed for textbooks.

Finally, as part of a scholarship enhancement pilot, \$21,900 was spent on stipends to programs that provided release time for employees to attend credit-based coursework toward a degree, or fulfill requirements of those courses.
